WHICH POLITICAL INSTITUTIONS DO KAZAKHSTAN PEOPLE TRUST THE MOST? (based on August 2022 results)

The confidence of the population in political institutions is the basis of the stability of any political system. In Kazakhstan, the level of trust in all political institutions exceeds half of those surveyed. This is evidenced by the results of regional sociological monitoring conducted by KazISS in August 2022 in all 17 regions and 3 cities of national importance.

The President of the country enjoys the greatest trust of the population among political power institutions, he is trusted by 83.9% of respondents (in the sum of answers "I trust" and "I rather trust"). The Government and the Army are also in the top three in terms of trust (61.5% each).

The level of trust in the Head of State has remained steadily high over the past few measurements, fluctuating slightly (within 3-5%) in both directions. In February 2022, for example, the sum of those who trust the President reached 81.4%, in May 2022-87.1%, and in August 2022-83.9%.

The lowest level of trust in the RK Government was recorded in February 2022 - 53.2%, by May it had increased markedly (to 68.0%), in August 2022 it was 61.5%.
